### **New Lectionary for Mass**

From the first Sunday of Advent, 1st December, 2024, the translation of the Scripture Readings for Mass and the celebration of the Sacraments is changing. The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version - Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter for the Psalms. Each parish will need to purchase a new set of Lectionaries which is composed of four volumes at a cost of £695.00 per set.

In order to benefit from a 15% discount for St. Alban's and St. Patrick's, Fr. Patterson has ordered and paid for a set for each parish at the cost of £1,181.50 - (£590.75 per parish).
